



Before school




- Maternity and infant clinics for everyone free of charge
- Under 1 year: Mainly at home
- 1 to 2 years: 41 % at daycare
- 3 to 5 years: 73 % at daycare
- 6 years: Compulsory pre-school
- 92 % of day care organised by municipalities



Why is Finnish educational system so successful?



Education in considered a key factor for future competitiveness, security and prosperity



1. Education for all

Everyone has the right to basic education free of charge







2. Educating competent teachers





Teacher training institutions can select heavily – e.g. only **1 out of 10** applicants are taken into class teacher education

Teachers feel valued:

- 90 % satisfied with their job
- 70 % would choose teaching career again
- 60 % thinks their work is valued in society



Kielten aineenopettajan kandidaatti- ja maisteriohjelma

Kielten opettajana teet yhteiskunnallisesti ja kulttuurisesti merkittävää ihmissuhdetyötä ja olet rakentamassa monikielistä ja kansainvälistä Suomea. Opettajan työ on luovaa, itsenäistä ja monipuolista. Sinusta tulee kasvatuksen ja koulutuksen ammattilainen. Käsissäsi opetussuunnitelma muuttuu eläväksi opetukseksi ja vuorovaikutukseksi luokassa ja muissa oppimisympäristöissä.

Pääset jakamaan ja rakentamaan tietoa yhdessä opiskelijoiden ja oppilaitoksen muiden ammattilaisten kanssa ja tukemaan opiskelijoiden kehittymistä vastuullisiksi kansalaisiksi. Opettajat pitävät työtään haastavana, merkityksellisenä ja palkitsevana.

- opettajan pedagogiset opinnot +
- viestintä- ja kieliopinnot +
- vapaavalintaiset opinnot (esim. toisen kielen tai muun opetettavan aineen opinnoista)

Kehität opiskelemiesi kielten kieli- ja viestintätaitoja ja perehdyt kielitieteeseen sekä kielialueen kulttuuriin ja yhteiskuntaan. Kandidaatti- ja maisteriopintojen tutkielmilla ja niiden aihevalinnoilla syvennät sekä kielialan että kielen oppimisen ja opettamisen osaamistasi.






Emphases of Curriculum 2014/ I

 - Thinking and learning to learn
 - Cultural identity, interaction and self-expression
 - Life skills
 - Multi-literacy
 - ICT skills
 - Work life skills and entrepreneurship
 - Participation, active involvement and building sustainable future
- => School subjects still have an important role in teaching and learning



Emphases of Curriculum 2014/ II

Multi-disciplinary, phenomenon- and project-based studies

- Several teachers with any given number of students
- At least once per school year
- Students expected to participate in the planning process
- Topics and means decided at local and school level





Emphases of Curriculum 2014/ III

Formative assessment What is the main task of assessment?

- Developing assessment for learning and assessment as learning
- Helping students to
 - learn to understand and analyze their own learning process
 - take more responsibility over their learning
- Fostering ability to learn


